

- b. Maintain a maintenance of traffic plan with the appropriate signage and flagmen to ensure a safe crossing for the trucks and a required safe route for traffic on CR 117.
 - c. Make repairs to CR 117 right-of-way and roadway as requested by Public Works after the dirt piles has been removed.
2. Require Power Corporation to look for an alternative location to dispose of the dirt material.
 3. Deny the permit request from Power Corporation.

4. It is expressly stipulated that this permit is a license for permissive use only and that the placing of facilities upon public property pursuant to this permit shall not operate to create or vest any property right in said holder.

5. Whenever necessary for the construction, repair, improvement, maintenance, safe and efficient operation, alteration or relocation of all, or any portion of said highway as determined by the County Director of Public Works and/or his employees, any or all of said poles, wires, pipes, conduits, cables or other facilities and appurtenances authorized hereunder, shall be removed from said highway, or reset or relocated thereon as required by the County, and at the expense of the permittee.

6. All work shall meet County standards and The Florida Department of Transportation's "Utility Accommodation Manual". All work will be subject to the approval of the Sumter County Director of Public Works and/or his employees.

7. All materials and equipment shall be subject to inspection by the County's Director of Public Works and/or his employees.

8. All County property and right-of-way shall be restored to its original condition as far as practical, in keeping with County specifications and/or the Florida Department of Transportation's "Utility Accommodation Manual" and in a manner satisfactory to the County. Open cuts of road and shoulder pavements are not allowed unless specifically approved by the Director of Public Works. If an open cut

As approved it must conform to Pages 4-6 of this permit. Jack and bores shall conform to page 6. Other types of directional drilling between roadways will be submitted for approval.

9. All installations shall conform to the edition of the Florida Department of Transportation's "Utility Accommodations Manual" which is in effect on the date the permit is approved.
10. The attached sketch or plans, covering details of this installation, shall be made a part of this permit. This approved permit with plans and Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) shall be on site at all times. Use FDOT Design Standards 600 Index Section as applicable.
11. The permittee shall commence actual construction in good faith within ninety (90) days from the date of said permit approval and shall be completed within 70 days.
12. The construction and maintenance of such utility shall not interfere with the property and rights of a prior permittee.
13. It is understood and agreed that the rights and privileges herein set out are granted only to the extent of the County's right, title and interest in the land to be entered upon and used by the holder, and the holder will, at all times, assume all risk of and indemnify, defend and save harmless the County of Sumter and the Sumter County Public Works Division from and against any and all loss, damage, cost or expense arising in any manner on account of the exercise or attempted exercises by said holder of the aforesaid rights and privileges. During construction, all safety regulations of the County and/or the Florida Department of Transportation's "Roadway and Traffic Design Standards" shall be observed and the holder must take such measures, including placing and display of safety devices, as may be necessary in order to safely conduct the public through the project area in accordance with the County's safety regulations and/or the Florida Department of Transportation's "Roadway and Traffic Design Standards".
14. The office of the Director of Public Works named in paragraph six (6) shall be notified twenty-four (24) hours in advance before starting work.
15. In the case of noncompliance with the County's and/or the Florida Department of Transportation's "Utility Accommodation Manual" this permit is void and the facility will have to be brought in compliance or removed from the right-of-way at no cost to the County.

4. THE PERMITEE AGREES TO UNDERTAKE REPAIRS TO THE ABOVE ROADWAY WITHIN 30 CALENDAR DAYS OF RECEIVING WRITTEN NOTIFICATION BY THE COUNTY. SHOULD THE PERMITEE NOT UNDERTAKE OR COMMENCE WORK WITHIN 30 CALENDAR DAYS THE COUNTY SHALL UTILIZE THE BOND OR CASHIERS CHECK TO FACILITATE REPAIRS.
5. THE COUNTY WILL REIMBURSE THE UNUSED PORTION OF THE CASH POSTED.
6. THE PERMITEE SHALL NOTIFY THE COUNTY AND REAPPLY FOR A NEW PERMIT SHOULD THE DAILY NUMBER OF LOADS INCREASE BY 10%.
7. OPERATIONS MUST OCCUR MONDAY – FRIDAY DURING DAYLIGHT HOURS ONLY.
8. PERMIT (COPY) MUST BE CARRIED IN EACH AND EVERY VEHICLE EXCEEDING 26,000 POUNDS (G.V.W.R) WHEN ON THE ROADWAY SPECIFIED.
