HISTORY/FACTS/ISSUES:

Sumter County Public Works/Road and Bridge Department received a request from Dennis Johnson, City of Webster Police Chief, requesting assistance with the 12th Annual Richloam Sportman Association and Florida Wildlife Commission/Forestry clean up in the Richloam area of Sumter County.

For the past eleven years Sumter County Public Works Division's (PWD) Road and Bridge Department along with the Sumter County CDA working in conjunction with the Florida Wildlife Commission and the Forestry Department has supported with the annual cleanup with dumpsters, loaders, and personnel.

The Richloam Sportman's Association is requesting the same support from PWD as last year. This year's event will take place on Saturday, September 29, 2012.

If approved, PWD would provide:

- 1 - Two county employees with pickup trucks
- 2 - County inmate crew of four
- 3 - Three (40) yard bins along with the county roll-off truck
- 4 - Loader
- 5 - Provide disposal for the collected materials.

The estimated for this year's event is \$1,000.00 or less.

Options for the BOCC to consider:

- Option 1: Allow PWD to assist with this year's cleanup event with an estimated cost of \$1,000.00.
- Option 2: Do not assist with this year's cleanup event.
