HISTORY/FACTS/ISSUES:

This contract is for the performance of the 2012-2013 Florida Division of Emergency Management Hazards Analysis. This contract was fulfilled for year 2011-2012 by Sumter County Fire & EMS.

The Hazards Analysis process is mandated under the Federal Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act, Title III of the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986, 42 U.S.C.s. 11001, et seq. (SARA) and the Florida Hazardous Materials Emergency Response and Community Right-to-Know Act of 1988, Chapter 252, Part II Florida Statutes.

The Hazards Analysis requires site visits and submission of findings to the Florida Division of Emergency Management. This year there are 13 sites which are required to be visited and reported on. The reports are due by November 1, 2012 (50%) and February 1, 2013 (50%).
