HISTORY/FACTS/ISSUES:

Back in July 2012, Savko received BOCC approval to close C-462 for track upgrades. Kyle Massie with Savko has requested the closure this section of tracks again from 2/14/13 to 3/8/13 to complete the same upgrades to the "second" section of tracks/spur in this crossing.

Savko and CSX will be responsible for the Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) plan and implementation of this plan. ACME Barricades has been selected by Savko to develop the MOT plan which will utilize the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) and Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Design Standards. ACME Barricades will supply and maintain all MOT devices for detours and routes.

Four Variable Message Boards (VMB) will be set-up seven days prior to the road closing and stay in place until this operation is complete. Savko will contact the Sumter County Sheriff's Office and other appropriate public service departments to notify them of the upcoming detour and designated routes that will be used. FDOT will also be contacted as several state roads will be utilized for this project. In addition, local businesses have been notified of the upcoming road closure.
