

RESOLUTION NO. 2009 - _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF SUMTER COUNTY, FLORIDA, DESIGNATING CERTAIN
ROADS WITHIN THE LAKE PANASOFFKEE COMMUNITY AS
APPROPRIATE FOR THE OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS

WHEREAS, the Sumter County Board of County Commissioners has adopted an ordinance permitting the operation of golf carts on the roads and streets in Sumter County as specifically designated through a duly enacted resolution of the Board, and

WHEREAS, citizens in the Lake Panasoffkee residential community have requested that certain roads and streets within their community be so designated as golf cart appropriate, and

WHEREAS, Section 316.212 (3); Florida Statutes, provides that golf carts may be operated on county roads only during the hours between sunrise and sunset, unless the government with jurisdiction determines that golf carts may be operated during the hours after sunset and before sunrise so long as the golf carts are equipped with headlights, brake lights, turn signals, and windshields, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Sumter County has determined that the operation of golf carts within the area shown on "Exhibit A" is beneficial to the residents of the Lake Panasoffkee community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Sumter County, Florida, as follows:

1. The Board has determined that golf carts may safely travel on or cross the roads and streets designated herein, taking into consideration the speed, volume and character of the motor vehicles using such roads and streets.

2. The roads located within "Exhibit A" are hereby designated as appropriate for the operation of golf carts in accordance with applicable provisions of the Sumter County Code:

ALL ROADS AND STREETS WITHIN "EXHIBIT A" EXCEPT ANY ROAD OR STREET WITH A POSTED SPEED LIMIT OF 35 MPH OR GREATER.

3. Golf carts shall be permitted to operate on the designated roads or streets within "Exhibit A" per Section 316.212 (3) Florida Statutes.

4. Nothing herein shall authorize the operation on the designated roads and streets within the jurisdiction of the State of Florida or any municipality.

5. A copy of this resolution shall be spread among the minutes of this Board and shall be furnished to the Sumter County Sheriff and other appropriate authorities as directed from time to time.
