

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SUMTER COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE LEVYING OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR SUMTER COUNTY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2009-2010; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Sumter County, Florida, on September 14, 2009, adopted Fiscal Year 2000-2010 Tentative Millage Rates following a public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Sumter County, Florida, held a public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation with Sumter County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the Board of County Commissioners as \$6,176,209,329.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Sumter County, Florida, that:

- 1) The FY 2009-2010 operating millage rate is 6.0100 mills, which is lesser than the rolled-back rate of 6.0220 mills by .20%.
- 2) The voted debt service millage is 0.
- 3) This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
