



The immediate needs and housing portion of the Jail Expansion are targeted for completion in February, 2009. During discussion on cost savings by utilizing owner direct purchasing, Mr. Arnold advised that there has been a savings of approximately \$250,000 in taxes to date and the project is approximately \$1,000,000 under budget.
