CR 470 and Animal Control Facility Ribbon Cutting Ceremony

Bushnell, FL -

The Sumter County Board of County Commissioners will be holding a Ribbon Cutting Ceremony for the CR 470 Project and the new Animal Control Facility on Tuesday, November 24, 2009.

The Ribbon Cutting for CR 470 will beginning at 2:00 p.m. The event will be held at the intersection of CR 529 and CR 470 (Solid Waste Facility entrance) in Lake Panasoffkee.



The major improvements accomplished are:

- Mill and resurface the existing roadway.
- Added one foot wide paved shoulders.
- Added a west bound to north bound exclusive right turn lane at the intersection of US 301.
- Added an east bound to south bound exclusive turn lane at the intersection of US 310.
- Pave the existing acceleration and deceleration lanes at the intersection of CR 529A.
- Construct new pavement markings.

The Ribbon Cutting for Animal Control will be held at 2:30 p.m. located at 821 CR 529 in Lake Panasoffkee.



The Board of County Commissioners entered into contract on May 26, 2009 with Vitetta Group serving as the Architect and Slack Construction Inc. serving as the General Contractor for construction of the new Animal Control Facility. Construction commenced in June of 2009 and was completed in October of 2009.
