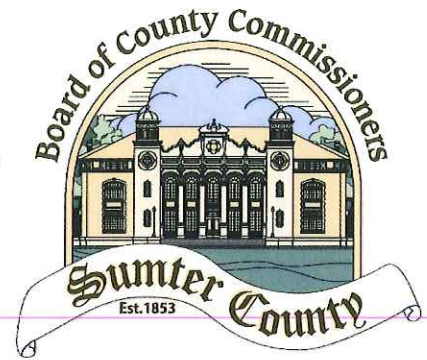

All 59 of those animals were chickens seized from a cruelty investigation case in which they died as a result of being extremely emaciated and neglected. This case has been submitted to the State Attorney's Office for review and action as they deem appropriate.
